



## CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

The National Student Show & Conference is seeking design educators to present at the Educator's Forum, a series of breakout sessions specifically crafted for design educators.

These sessions range from single presentations, to paneled discussions with judges and professionals, as well as open discussion with colleagues from across the nation on the challenges, trends and opportunities your program may be encountering. Together, we hope to shape the future of design education.

The Educator's Forum is looking for 2–3 general session speakers. Speakers will be chosen in a peer-reviewed process based on the Abstracts they submit. Abstracts on any design or education-related topics are welcome.

This year's conference theme is "Stand out for Yourself." Abstracts that incorporate this theme message will be given extra consideration in their review.

The following formats of presentations will be accepted:

### **Presentation**

- ★ 30-minute
- ★ 20/30-minute presentation followed by 10-minute discussion/Q&A

### **Deadline: February 28th.**

The National Student Show & Conference 14 is seeking from design educators or practitioners proposals that address issues in design education and research for 30-minute presentations as breakout sessions to be held during the conference.

### **Presentation Abstract Submission Procedure**

- ★ Paper/presentation abstracts (a maximum of 300 words) must be submitted in PDF format only.
- ★ Your name and name of institution (if any) should NOT appear on the abstract, as we wish for the judging to be blind.
- ★ Include your status (tenure track faculty, tenured faculty, visiting faculty, practicing designer, other) on the PDF file.

- ★ Clearly indicate this is for a PRESENTATION.
- ★ Title your PDF file as an abbreviation of your paper title and use the file extension .pdf (e.g. titlename.pdf).
- ★ Include in your email: your name, institution, institution type (2-year, 4-year, public, private, art school, etc.)
- ★ Notification of acceptance will be made via email near the beginning of March.
- ★ If selected, the complete paper will be requested for inclusion in the conference proceedings.
